

Outdoor Painting Suggested Packing List (necessary items will be starred)

small sketchbook (pocket size 3 x 4 or similar)
black medium marker
pencil
view finder
red filter
color finder
*digital camera

*paint (in media of your choice) basic colors listed below
*medium (if you use one)
*brushes
*palette knife, small
*solvent and container (water for watermedia such as acrylic or watercolor)
*painting substrate: canvas boards, canvas pad, watercolor paper etc.
spray bottle (watermedia only)
handi wipes
*cotton rags, paper towels or other
*grocery trash bags (very light and packable, has handles)

*easel
*palette
*wet painting carrier (simple boxtop or pizza box works)
*supply carrier; backpack, fanny pack, rolling cart etc. (old rolling carry-on suitcase is great)
stool (optional)

*hat
*long sleeved shirt
comfortable footwear
extra sweatshirt, vest or jacket
gloves w/o fingertips (for cold weather)

*sunscreen
bug spray (optional)
lotion/barrier cream (gloves in a bottle, silicone glove)
waterless hand cleaner
tissue pack
small first aid kit

snacks
*water bottle

suggested basic paint colors:

Titanium white
Cadmium Yellow Light or Pale, (or Hansa Yellow Medium)
Cadmium Red Light (or Medium or Scarlet)
Permanent Alizarin Crimson (or Quinacridone Red, Q. Magenta or Q. Violet)
Ultramarine Blue
Cerulean Blue, Cobalt Blue or Manganese Blue Hue
Viridian or Viridian Hue

Other useful colors:

Naples Yellow Light (I like Utrecht)
Terra Rosa (or Indian Red, Venetian Red, Light Red Oxide or similar) or Burnt Sienna
Yellow Ochre, Yellow Oxide or Mars Yellow
Sap Green
Cadmium Yellow Lemon (or Primrose), or Hansa Yellow Light

Pthalo green can be used instead of Viridian, it is much cheaper. Warning! Pthalo colors are very strong, you need only a little to go a long way.
